



The BAJC Baosteel Funding 2024 - Call for Applications

Background

The Baosteel-Australia Joint Research and Development Centre (BAJC) is a joint venture between Baosteel - one of the world's largest steel companies, and five Australian universities - The University of Queensland, The University of New South Wales, Monash University, University of Wollongong and Deakin University. Baosteel provides funding for BAJC to conduct joint research on industrial technology and applications, aiming to develop innovative technologies that interest Baosteel and align with the research capacities of the participating universities.

For 2024, Baosteel will provide up to \$2,000,000 in funding for research projects through BAJC. Applications for this funding are now open. The selected projects are expected to commence on 1 January 2025 and will receive up to AUD \$150,000 per year for a maximum of three years.

Application Process

The Baosteel funding application process consists of two stages: Expression of Interest (EOI) and Full Proposal. Applicants are invited to submit an EOI, which should succinctly outline the project proposal, using the prescribed EOI Template. EOIs should be sent to admin@bajc.org.au by the specified due date. The BAJC Advisory Technical Panel and Baosteel's selection committee will evaluate the submissions. Highly ranked EOIs will then be invited to submit full proposals for further evaluation.

Due Date

Call for EOI: Monday 03 June 2024

Closing EOI: Friday 28 June 2024

Invitation for Full Proposal: Approximately mid-July 2024

Outcome Announcement: Approximately mid-October 2024
